Dear Parents

Welcome back to Year 2! I hope you all enjoyed the summer holidays and found some time to relax!

Our topic this term is called 'What do I need to be me?' Our English work will be initially focused around the poem 'Hurt no Living thing' by Christina Rossetti. We will be learning poems and riddles about animals. As part of the speaking and listening element of the English curriculum I will be doing 'Show and Tell' on a Friday morning. I will put a list outside the classroom to show which group your child is in. Our English work this term will link in to our Science topic learning about human and animal life cycles. I am hoping there will be a surprise in the class for the children at some point next week!

In Math's we will be focusing on two digit number, two digit addition and subtraction, and counting in our 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's.

The children will be doing games with Mr Taylor on a Monday afternoon and P.E with me on a Thursday morning. Can you please ensure the children have their P.E kit in school on both of these days. While the weather is still suitable games will take place outside so please ensure children have suitable trainers and clothing.

This year Robins have the chance to do Forest Schools on a Friday afternoon. Can you please ensure you have completed the permission slip so your child can participate. Children will need to come into school on a Friday in their Forest School clothes; please ensure your child is wearing a long sleeved top to protect their arms. They will also need to have a pair of wellies in school.

I will continue to put spellings in the reading records on a Monday and the children will be tested on the following Monday. In addition to spellings I intend to give out homework on a Friday to be handed in by the following Thursday. This will be one piece a week and I will alternate between Maths, Topic and Grammar. Please come and speak to me if you have any concerns about this.

I will be doing 'Show and Tell' with the children
Please continue to provide a water bottle that can stay in the classroom.

Lastly, it would be very much appreciated if we could please ask for a £2.00 contribution towards the extra snack the children enjoy each day in addition to their fruit.
