Shanghai Leadership Exchange

Last Wednesday a group of 10 students and two adults from Shanghai visited our school. Ambassadors from our school showed the students and teachers around the school. Play time was enjoyed together, then the students joined our Owls,





Woodpeckers, and Swans classes to observe a lesson. They then gave a short lesson themselves. Lots of Chinese phrases were repeated and practised, numbers chanted and singing of 'Head shoulders knees and toes' in Chinese could be heard around the school. This was all followed by a scrummy school lunch. Finally, they managed to participate in Collective Worship before they departed. It was a totally rewarding experience for our pupils as well as our visitors, everyone enjoyed the day. Thanks must go to staff at King Edward VI School, who organised the day for these

young people to visit primary schools with in the Bury School Partnership.
