Some cash was taken but the main cost to the school will be in repairing the damage and the time and inconvenience caused. Many of you already pay for school dinners on line and we thought it would be a suitable time to request that as many of you as possible consider paying for lunches, uniform and trips using the Suffolk County Council online payment system. Rock Steady Music School - Rock Stars Wanted!

Last Thursday, we had a half hour assembly with Steve from The Rock Steady Music School. Hopefully your child came home full of enthusiasm and excitement about an opportunity to perform in a band! After Christmas we will be welcoming Rocksteady Music School to Great Whelnetham School. It's an amazing opportunity for your child to join their very own rock band and learn either drums, guitar, keyboard or vocals. Music sessions will take place in school every Friday afternoon and help to build confidence whilst also teaching resilience, teamwork and listening skills.

If you are interested in the sessions your child can learn either drums, guitar, keyboard or vocals within their very own band. Sessions are taught by highly trained musicians and are fun, inclusive and accessible to all. At the end of each term the bands perform a concert for the school and their families, so you can see how far they have come! All instruments are provided and no experience is necessary. Payment is £31.25 payable by monthly direct debit.

On Friday 15th December, Steve will return to do 3 workshops where children can try out the instruments and learn all about being a musician in a band. If your child is interested and you want to find out more, do pop along, Steve will be here from 9.00am.

Workshop 1 (Reception/Year 1) will take place 9.30-10.00am

Workshop 2 (Years 2, 3 & 4) will take place 10.00-10.30am

Workshop 3 (Years 5 & 6) will take place 10.30-11.00am.
