Dear Parents,

Our topic for this half term is 'What did the Romans do for us?' This fascinating unit introduces the children to the mighty Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. We will be looking at what life was like in Rome two thousand years ago, how Roman society was organized and investigating the remarkable life of Julius Caesar. In our English lessons we will be writing biographies, newspaper reports and persuasive letters. In geography we will be studying Italy, looking at both the physical and human features. We will also be looking at what the Romans used to eat and in our design and technology lessons we will be making our own Roman meal!
