Curriculum Learning

This term we look forward to learning about our exciting new topics, please find below information about our learning:

In English we will continue to develop our reading and writing skills. We will be learning fiction adventure stories with a focus on Pirates! Our key text is The Night Pirates!

In Maths we are learning about multiplication and division. We will also start to look at fractions. We will continue to count in our 2,s 5,s and 10's.

'Oceans and Seas' is our topic for this term. We are currently learning about boats and ships from the past and will be learning about a significant event from the past 'Titanic'. In Science we are investigating 'Habitats' with a focus on the Ocean and water habitats. In DT the children will be designing and making various boats.
