## Arrangements for returning to school 8th March 2021

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to welcome all of our children back to school from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021.

We thought that we would write to you ahead of time to outline the procedures for arrivals and collections on return. Our children will remain in their classroom bubbles and previous lockdown procedures remain in place with regards to social distancing and gates to arrive and exit from school.

We recognise that this could be an anxious time for some children and class teachers will make adjustments for this during the first week back. The mornings will continue with Maths and English lessons and the afternoons will focus on an exciting Science theme: Innovations for the Future during this first week back.

To continue to observe social distancing and keep 2 metres apart, we ask families to drop off and collect children promptly to limit crowds or clusters of people in any one place. Please continue to wear your masks.
