I did notice on the home learning BBC bitesize this week the **topic lesson is 'Who was Neil Armstrong?**' which I thought the children might love as this had been our topic when we finished!

The White Rose online lessons this week would also be good for recapping as Year 1 is on Fractions and Year 2 is on length with some problem solving challenges!

If you would like to continue with spellings Twinkl has the next 6 week plan: Type in either: Year 1 Spellings Term 3A Year 2 spellings Term 3A

There are also the statutory common exception words that were enclosed in your home learning folder to practice.
