There will be a special cathedral service of celebration for church schools on Sunday 7th October at 5.30pm. The service will involve drama, song and dance from different schools and lots of children will be taking part. We will celebrate part of the family of church schools in this diocese. Crimson Glory—Sunday 4th November 6.00pm

'Crimson Glory' is a large-scale event to commemorate the centenary of the end of the First World War. The production will involve not only a professional orchestra and choir, but the St Edmundsbury Cathedral Choir, Ex Silentio, No Girls Allowed, Sixth Form Dance and Drama students and approximately 200 children from local primary schools from within the Bury Schools Partnership. There will also be an art exhibition at the Cathedral with art work from the schools in the Bury Schools Partnership.
